Your leadership has spent countless hours bargaining in good faith with Management since May, addressing issues identified on the surveys completed by the membership before negotiations opened. No issue has been taken lightly and must be discussed to fully represent this membership completely.

Even with all the work put in up to this point, we have still not completed the process of achieving a tentative agreement that would address the issues.

At this time, there continues to be positive movement and key issues are still being addressed, so the current contract has been agreed to extend through November 15<sup>th</sup>.

This extension, as the previous extension, includes retro-activity for any wage increases back to June 5<sup>th</sup>.

The Bargaining Committee and the International Staff are working hard to reach an agreement on behalf of our members and their families.

The bargaining will continue to be sure to address all the items that affect our membership, as part of the process.
