Members must have (1) one continuous year of good standing to be eligible to run.

The lottery to determine order of names on the ballot will be held at the UAW Local 1005 Union Hall on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 at 12:00 Noon. Candidates can attend, if they wish.

Elections will be held at the Casino:

Wednesday, October 4, 2017, 11:00 am – 11:00 pm

Friday, October 6, 2017, 12:00 Noon to 12:30am Saturday, October 7, 2017.

- 1. UAW / Gaming Unit Bargaining Chairperson:** All UAW represented members assigned to Table Games and Slot Performance and in good standing with the UAW and UAW Local 1005 and assigned to any shift may run in the election for this position. This position will handle bargaining with Management, assist Committeepersons in grievance handling while working closely with Local, Regional and International UAW Representatives for the entire UAW represented members working at the J.A.C.K. Casino CLE.
  - When none of the candidates for Gaming Chairperson receives more than fifty percent of the votes cast, there shall be a run-off election between the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes.
  - The run-off election will be held Wednesday, October 18, 2017 if needed.
- 2. UAW / Gaming Unit Bargaining Vice Chairperson:** All UAW represented members assigned to Table Games and Slot Performance and in good standing with the UAW and UAW Local 1005 and assigned to any shift may run in the election for this position. This position will assist the Unit Bargaining Chairperson with the duties listed above.
  - When none of the candidates for Gaming Vice Chairperson receives more than fifty percent of the votes cast, there shall be a run-off election between the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes.
  - The run-off election will be held Wednesday, October 18, 2017 if needed.
- 3. Table Games Shift Committeeperson:** Members holding a specific shift may run for this position on the shift they are assigned. The shift committeeperson will represent the members of the shift that they are elected.
  - Number of Committeepersons per shift: Day = 1, Swing = 1, Sunrise = 1.
  - Each Table Games Committeeperson will be elected by the candidate receiving the highest number of votes for that shift.
  - In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by a coin flip or mutual agreement by the candidates.
- 4. Table Games Alternate Committeeperson:** Members holding a specific shift may run for this position on the shift they are assigned. The Alternate Committeeperson will represent the members on the shift that they are elected to when the Committeeperson is unavailable.
  - Number of Alternate Committeepersons per shift: Day = 3, Swing = 3, Sunrise = 3
  - Each shift may vote for up to 3 Alternate Committeepersons. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be the first alternate, the second highest will be the second alternate and the third highest will be the third alternate.
  - In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by a coin flip or mutual agreement by the candidates.
- 5. Slot Performance Committeeperson and Alternate Committeeperson:** Members in this classification may run for these positions.
  - This group will elect one (1) Committeeperson and one (1) Alternate Committeeperson to represent all 3 shifts. Candidates with highest number of votes will be the winner at each position.
  - In case of a tie in either position, the winner will be determined by a coin flip or mutual agreement by the candidates.
