**RE:** Update – GM's Response to UAW's Objections

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

I wanted to give you an update that GM responded to the UAW's objections of December 3, 2018, and they disagree with our position. We are in the process of scheduling a meeting after the Holiday Shutdown to discuss their announcement on November 26, 2018, and further our argument regarding plant closings.

At the direction of President Gary Jones, we are continuing to apply legal, political, contractual and social pressure on General Motors to reverse their decision to close U.S. plants.

We are asking you, the Leadership, to reach out to our members, your neighbors, church groups, politicians, to write to General Motors. We have the letter writing campaign on UAW.org. General Motors needs to know that people are mad about their investments in Mexico while closing U.S. plants.
