2017 PERFORMANCE BONUS LUMP SUM PAYMENT:

- **Payment**
The payment of the Performance Bonus Lump Sum Payment (Paragraph (99)(a)) will be paid to eligible members in Roll 23 (week ending June 4, 2017) and distributed during week ending June 11, 2017.
- **Eligibility**
The eligibility date for this payment is May 15, 2017. Members who were active, on FMLA, or temporary layoff on May 15, 2017, or went on a qualifying Leave of Absence within 90 days of May 15, 2017, are defined as eligible. Such eligible members shall receive a Lump sum Payment of \$1,000.
- **Overtime Recalculation Payment**
Per the Fair Labor Standard Act (FLSA), eligible members that were paid overtime during the qualifying year will receive an additional \$0.20 per hour for all premium (time and one half or double time) hours paid. This additional payment will be included in members' pay distributed week ending June 18, 2017. (Example – Eligible member was paid a total of 400 premium hours (time and one half or double time) in qualifying year = $400 \times \$0.20 = \80.00 additional payment in pay distributed week ending June 18, 2017).

ELECTION COMMITTEE: The Election Committee received an official letter of intent to resign as Vice-President from Dan Schwartz postmarked May 30, 2017.

This closes out the resignation time window for newly elected officials to run for President. Due to this resignation, there is a vacancy for the office of Vice-President. At the time of this letter, we plan on holding an election for President and Vice-President.

Brother Dan Schwartz will remain Acting President until the day after the election held on Thursday, July 13, 2017. The new Election notice will be posted in the days following the General Membership Meeting. On Sunday, June 11, 2017, at the General Membership Meeting, all newly elected Executive Officers, including the Election Committee and the Retiree Executive Board will be given the opportunity to voice their resignation with the intent to run for Vice-President, or any office that becomes available. All elected individuals named above will be notified by phone of Sunday's agenda.
