- GM announced Friday that Lordstown will be going to one shift effective 2018. The Shop Committee is working with Management to determine the impact this will have on Parma. As of now, Lordstown accounts for about 20% of Parma's overall volume.
- GM also announced there will be a Special Attrition Program (SAP) for eligible employees.
 - * The SAP is being offered to all Production and Skilled Trades Employees at Parma and Lordstown.
 - * Eligible employees will have 45 days from the roll-out to select from the following options:
 - a. Retire effective July 1, 2018 under the normal or voluntary provisions of the 2015 UAW-GM Hourly Pension Plan for a \$60,000 cash payment.
 - b. Production only – Voluntarily quit General Motors effective July 1, 2018 and receive a cash payment based on seniority or credited service (whichever is greater). The amount of the cash payment is:

* 0 years or more but less than 5 years:	\$ 5,000
* 5 years or more but less than 10 years:	\$15,000
* 10 years or more but less than 20 years:	\$45,000
* 20 years or more:	\$50,000
