PROFIT SHARING: There will be a payment of \$11,000 made on February 26th for eligible employees. Profit sharing is based on last years' hours worked. You needed to have 1850 hours to receive the maximum payment. Less than 1850 hours will receive a percentage based on those hours. Eligible retirees will receive their payment on March 25th.

SAP: Every eligible employee who signed up for the SAP will receive the \$60,000. Those employees will be released by May 1st.

LOCAL AGREEMENT: has been ratified by the membership and approved by the International Executive Board.
