RE: **3% General Wage Increase – UAW General Motors National Council Dues**

Dear Union Brothers and Sisters:

In accordance with 2019 National Negotiations, there will be a 3% General Wage Increase for eligible members on Monday, September 14, 2020. This General Wage Increase will bring the average assembler rate to \$30.95.

Article 1, Paragraph 10 of the UAW National General Motors Council Bylaws state, "Each General Motors Local Union and/or General Motors unit shall pay a monthly per capita of 1.5 percent of the current assembler wage rate per dues paying member and such payment shall be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer of the International Union".

The 3% General Wage Increase effective Monday, September 14, 2020, will increase UAW-GM Council Dues by one (1) cent per member per month. This will bring the Council Dues per member per month to 46 cents.

Local Unions are required to submit National Council Dues by the 20th of each month via the LUIS System when sending the normal per capita dues. Simply select the option of GM Council Dues, enter the number of members and the amount of payment.

Therefore, in order to ensure compliance with the National Council Bylaws and remain a member in good standing, each Local should submit dues consistent with the information outlined above.
